The deadline for English language articles is **March 1st 2018**; the deadline for articles in other languages is **February 1st**. Articles will be published either in English or in another language followed by an English translation. If the article is submitted in one of the languages listed above, the author will be responsible for submitting an English translation when the article is accepted for publication.

The papers should not be longer than 50.000 characters.

If papers are potentially fitting for the journal they will undergo a peer-review process. Authors will know if their paper is accepted by May 2018. The journal is scheduled to be published by June/July 2018.
